What is the Community Fridge?

- We collect surplus food from local supermarkets and make it available to the local community
- This is food the supermarkets would otherwise dispose of it may be food with damaged packaging, products the store are no longer selling or food which is no longer at it's best quality.
- The quality of food we have does therefore vary - please check the food before you eat it!
- The amount and types of food we have varies it can be fruit and veg, bread, pastries, tins and packets or frozen food.

When the community centre is open during the week we often have fruit, veg and bread available in our foyer area - please help yourself to what you can use. We also have a cupboard in our garden which sometimes has fruit and veg available in it.

The amount of food we have available varies depending on donations from supermarkets. We want to share the food amongst everyone who visits so may limit what you can take. You are welcome to visit the fridge as often as you like during the week but to ensure we can share our frozen food with all visitors we ask that you only visit the freezer section of our community fridge once each week.
